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GUIDANCE NOTES: APPLYING FOR AN INDIVIDUAL GRANT

About the Worrall and Fuller Charity

The charity began in 1689 and supports the education and training of children and young people in need who live in, or have parents working in, a specific part of south Islington, London. This area was formerly called Finsbury.

How we support children and young people

The charity provides small individual grants mostly ranging from £250 to £750. The grants are given only for educational purposes. This wide definition means we can consider lots of applications for help, but our current priorities are to support the following:

1. Extra-curricular, non-mainstream education, and out of school activities

These should be related to arts, sports, music lessons, dance, scouting etc, and for primary and secondary school age children up to the age of 18. We can support fees, equipment, clothing and trips etc. The activity should be structured and taught in groups or individually, and progress reports/certificates awarded that show attendance and progress.

2. School uniform and school study/training equipment costs (e.g. books, IT equipment)

3. Organised School trips during term-time with an educational purpose

4. School-leavers about to enter their first year in Further or Higher Education

We are prepared to support, and therefore get to know, children over a period of time as long as they can demonstrate progression in their field of interest, talent and learning. We will support school-leavers we have supported in the past who are about to go to further or higher education with grants towards study materials (not course fees).

How we make our decision

We use your application form firstly to check whether you are eligible and in need. You are required to submit a proof of your address that falls within the benefit area, it can also help if you send something like a letter from the child's school or the education/activity provider that supports the application. We will probably telephone you to discuss the application, and might ask you to drop into St Luke's Community Centre to chat with someone from Worrall and Fuller charity.

If you have been referred to us from another organisation, with your permission, we might speak to them too.

We meet four times a year to discuss new applications and make decisions. If your need for support is particularly urgent and you cannot wait until the next meeting for a decision, please state this on your form explaining why.
